SVHS

- Increase lighting in original classrooms for brightness (3)
- Improved science lab facilities (4)
- Guidance Counseling/Pupil Services office complex (4)
- Textbook storage areas (2)
- Smaller partitioned classrooms for special education/special services classes
- Department technology labs/accessibility
- Increase hallway locker size to mirror lockers in addition (2)
- Two story addition, possibly math/science wing
- Performing Arts Facility (4)
- Tech lab located between classrooms
- Remodel/expand kitchen and cafeteria area to accommodate increased enrollment (3)
- Restroom facilities for bus garage fields (soccer/baseball/softball)
- Create Additional administrative office space (4)
- Upgraded electrical capacity for technology (3)
- Foods/Child Care classrooms need updating/upgrading
- Storage areas including classrooms, extra-curricular, athletics (2)
- Expansion of weight training room (2)
- Expand locker rooms/PE and coaches offices
- Space needed for special education/bilingual/ESL
- Improve venting system
- Additional space for band/chorus due to numbers
- Display areas for student work

Meridian Junior High School

- Improve old gym acoustics
- Improve temperature control in 8th grade wing
- Assess different entry to MJH during day
- Demolish old gym, band room, old teachers' lounge, kitchen, boiler/mechanical room and storage building
- Construct new 2 or 3 story wing in place of demolished area which could house band/chorus; counseling/pupil services center; teachers lounge; storage area; art room; bilingual/ESL
- Improve environment in 8th grade wing (thermal windows, painted lockers, cabinets in classrooms, better air quality)
- Increase size of lockers
- Use full size science rooms as designed

- Space for special services (consistent issue for all buildings)
- Utilize current courtyard space
- Additional Lockers
- Wheelchair access to primary entrance (not done in last project)
