## Flower Bed Adoption Program

### **Program:**

The Meridian CUSD 223 Buildings and Grounds department is pleased to announce its "Flower Bed Adoption" program. The program's goal is to encourage public and community involvement in the beautification of the Meridian CUSD 223 facilities. The program is a volunteer-based activity, allowing area individuals and groups the opportunity to "adopt" a flower bed to maintain at the four facility sites.

### **Scope of Volunteer Work:**

- Remove and dispose of litter and weeds.
- Provide own hand tools for area maintenance. Supplies and equipment will be provided by the Meridians Buildings and Grounds department if and when needed.
- Notify Meridians Buildings and Grounds department contact of problems or concerns.
- Visit the site frequently to ensure good health of plant material.
- If applicable, maintain adequate signage of plant or display boards.
- Install mulch provided by Meridians Buildings and Grounds when needed.
- Plant and move plants approved by Meridians Buildings and Grounds contact.
- The expectation is that the volunteer(s) will prepare the bed prior to planting, plant the flowers, and weed the flowerbed at least weekly. Pinch back spent blooms, remove the plants and rake the bed after the first hard frost.
- If at any time Meridians Buildings and Grounds department deems the flowerbed to be unsightly, contact will be made with the organization contact person.
